RE: FOP Tags

The purpose of this correspondence is to clarify policy for issuance of FOP Tags.

In accordance with the Maryland State Lodge Bylaws and agreement with the Maryland Motor Vehicle Administration, FOP Logo tags will only be authorized for active members of the FOP; although the active member can request non-logo tags if preferred. Associate members are only authorized to obtain the non-logo tags. The member must be a registered owner/co-owner of the vehicle. The member must be in good standing with the FOP Lodge. The only exception to this policy is for surviving spouses of officers killed in the line of duty.

In addition, it is incumbent on the member to have the FOP tags removed/replaced when their name is no longer listed as an owner/co-owner of the vehicle.

In domestic dispute cases, it is suggested that the member replace the FOP tags while they are still listed owners/co-owners of the vehicle to avoid delay and difficulty in having tags removed later in the process. Generally, the only authority that the FOP lodge has is to request non-renewal of tags and shall not request a cancellation or pull order.

FOP tags are a privilege of FOP membership, and this privilege will be jeopardized by violations of our negotiated agreements.
